

# Part Time Student Enrollment

2010-2011

## High School Students--

- Core Curriculum and Electives

- Registration fee--\$200 annual (mandatory, non-refundable) + \$100 per class per month

This fee covers curriculum, student insurance on site and at Lifegate sponsored events off site, library use, events and celebrations, student placement testing, and mandatory field trips.

Note: four or more classes are considered full time

- Activities fee--\$110 annual (optional). This fee covers Outdoor School and Fall Retreat.
- Yearbook--\$55 (optional)
- Senior graduation fee--\$75 (optional) (does not include cap & gown or announcements)
- Sports Fee--\$210 (optional) (per sport payable prior to the first practice date)

## Middle School Students--

- Electives only

- Registration fee--\$200 annual (mandatory, non-refundable) + \$100 per class per month

This fee covers curriculum, student insurance on site and at Lifegate sponsored events off site, library use, events and celebrations, student placement testing, and mandatory field trips.

- Activities fee--\$110 annual (optional). This fee covers Outdoor School and Fall Retreat.
- Yearbook--\$55

Each student must have an interview with the Principal prior to enrollment.

The student will be asked to abide by the Student Handbook and to be on site for class times only.

Class credits will be given for work done at LCS; combined transcripts will be the responsibility of the student.

Tuition is payable by the 1<sup>st</sup> of each month, starting September 1<sup>st</sup> 2010 and ending June 1<sup>st</sup>, 2011 for a 10 month contract. Tuition payments received after the 10<sup>th</sup> will be considered late and will be assessed a \$25 late fee. Tuition must be paid on time for student to continue classes.

Students will be allowed to participate in sports, contingent upon current OSAA requirements.

Academic eligibility is the same as for full-time students.

A provisional certificate of achievement and opportunity to participate in the graduation ceremony will be given to seniors. To be included, student is required to have passing grades and all fees and tuition must be paid in full.

Note: Part time students are those enrolled in three or fewer classes. Four or more are considered full time. Part time students are not eligible for scholarship.
